TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14 (2)

Kent County Council gives notice that Orgaswick Avenue, Dymchurch will be closed to through traffic, on or after 15th September 2020 for up to 1 day.

The road will be closed outside number 18.

The alternative route is via Eastchurch Road and A259 Dymchurch Road.

This closure is necessary to enable overhead cable repairs to be carried out by UK Power Networks.

This Notice applies when the relevant signs and barriers are on site and is valid for a period of no more than 21 days.
