PROPOSALS FOR TOWN SQUARE, NEW ROMNEY HIGH STREET

New Romney Town Council is proposing the following changes to Town Square to make space for an outdoor seating area for the service of food and drink to be provided by adjacent businesses:

- Move Electric Supply Column that serves the annual Town Christmas Tree from directly outside Savages greengrocers (62, High Street) to the corner of 70, High Street
- Move Town Council noticeboard from outside 62, High Street and relocate elsewhere (preferred location between 2 new benches to be installed by the Southlands Almshouse Trust in rear of pavement outside the Methodist Church)
- Move Town Bench sited outside 64/66 High Street to the area in front of 72/74 High Street (adjacent disabled parking bay)
- Remove Silver Birch Tree (subject to required planning consent) and relocate on St. Martin's Field to replace a damaged tree
- Supply one additional litter bin adjacent the relocated bench
