PLANNING & ENVIRONMENT COMMITTEE POLICY STATEMENT AND TERMS OF REFERENCE

(i) Core Functions

To be delegated by the Town Council - except whereby it is deemed by the Clerk in consultation with the Chairman of the Committee that the Full Council be first consulted via the ratification process - the authority (by resolution of the Committee) to:

- (a) Consider the Planning and / or Licensing Applications submitted to the Folkestone & Hythe District Council or any other appropriate authority and to decide upon the observations to be submitted to that Council or authority.
- (b) Consider and make recommendations or observations upon any plans submitted by County, District, or any other Authority, which might affect this Council's area and those adjoining.
- (c) Consider Planning and / or Licensing Appeals and to inform the Town Clerk accordingly.
- (d) Carry out such other duties and functions relating to Planning and Licensing that may be conferred upon it by the Town Council from time to time.
- (e) Request the removal of powers delegated to an officer of the Planning Authority on any application as deemed necessary.
- (f) Send a copy of the Committee's observations, as a matter of courtesy, to the Local Parish/Town Council concerned when planning and / or licensing applications are submitted to the Committee for consultation purposes.
- (g) Speak publicly at Planning & Licensing Committee meetings in support of refusal or approval of particular Planning or Licensing Applications as directed by the Planning Committee or Town Council.
- (h) Respond to consultations relating to planning, licensing, environmental or highways matters.
- (i) Take any such action as may be deemed appropriate relating to planning, licensing, environmental or highways matters except in such case as such action would be likely to impact financially on the Council budget and / or reserves
- (j) Consider requests for areas and single properties to be designated Conservation Areas and/or Listed Buildings and to make recommendations accordingly.
- (k) Apply for Tree Preservation Orders or the retention of trees of significance where deemed necessary or desirable.

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- (I) Ensure that, as appropriate, due priority is given to the provision of recreation areas within areas of development and that local healthcare needs are duly highlighted when submitting planning observations.
- (m) Give support for the provision of small industrial units in designated industrial areas which will offer employment to local residents.
- (n) Consider environmental matters that may be placed before the Committee and take any such action as may be deemed appropriate except in such case as such action would be likely to impact financially on the Council budget and / or reserves.

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
