



Kent County Council DYMCHURCH ROAD, DYMCHURCH

TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 - Section 14 (2)

Kent County Council gives notice that Dymchurch Road, Dymchurch will be closed to through traffic, on or after 9th April 2025 for up to 2 days.

The road will be closed at the junctions of Dunstall Lane and High Knocke Estate.

The alternative route is via A259 Dymchurch Road, High Street, Hythe Road, Scanlons Bridge Road, A261 London Road, Hythe Road, A20 Ashford Road, Barrow Hill, Main Road, Hythe Road, Link Road Between Junction 10A M20 To A2070 Sevington, A2070 Bad Munstereifel Road, Bad Munstereifel Slip West Bound, (Bad Munstereifel Slip East Bound - in reverse), A2070 Hamstreet Bypass, Ashford Road, A2070 From Ashford Road To District Boundary, A2070 Rhee Wall To Ashford Road, A259 Rhee Wall, Lydd Road, High Street, Dymchurch Road and vice-versa.

It is planned that the road will be closed between 20:00 hrs and 6:00 hrs each day.

This closure is necessary to enable carriageway patching to be carried out by Kent County Council.

This Notice applies when the relevant signs and barriers are on site and is valid for a period of no more than 5 days.
