ST MARYS ROAD, NEW ROMNEY

TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14 (2)

Kent County Council gives notice that St Marys Road, New Romney will be closed to through traffic, on or after 14th August 2025 for up to 1 day.

The road will be closed at the junctions of Fairfield Road and A259 Dymchurch Road.

The alternative route is via Northbound via: A259 Dymchurch Road, High Street, Ashford Road and Fairfield Road. Southbound via: St Mary's Road, Cockreed Lane, Ashford Road, A259 High Street and Dymchurch Road.

It is planned that the road will be closed between 8:00 hrs and 17:00 hrs each day.

This closure is necessary to enable installation of pedestrian guard railing and bollards to be carried out by Kent County Council.

This Notice applies when the relevant signs and barriers are on site and is valid for a period of no more than 5 days.
