



A259 HYTHE ROAD, DYMCHURCH

TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 - Section 14 (2)

Kent County Council gives notice that A259 Hythe Road, Dymchurch will be closed to through traffic, on or after 6th September 2024 for up to 1 night.

The road will be closed between Burmarsh Road and Kingsway.

The alternative route is via A259 Hythe Road, A259 Dymchurch Road, Scanlons Bridge, A261 London Road, A261 Hythe Road, A20 Ashford Road, A20 Barrow Hill, A20 Main Road, A20 Hythe Road, A20 A2070 M20 J10a Roundabout, A2070 From M20 J10a Roundabout To A2070 Sevington Roundabout W, A2070 From M20 J10 Roundabout To J A2042 S, A2070 J A2042 Roundabout, A2070 From J A2070/B2080 Roundabout To J A2042, A259 J A2070/B2080 Roundabout, A259 Rhee Wall, A259 Lydd Road, A259 High Street, A259 Dymchurch Road and A259 High Street.

It is planned that the road will be closed between 20:00 and 06:00 each night.

This closure is necessary to enable carriageway resurfacing to be carried out by Kent County Council.

This Notice applies when the relevant signs and barriers are on site and is valid for a period of no more than 5 days.
