CLUBB LANE, BROOKLAND, ROMNEY MARSH

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

TEMPORARY ORDER 2021

To allow telegraph pole replacement works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Clubb Lane, Brookland, Romney Marsh.

Daytime closures are planned from Wednesday 20 January 2021 for up to 3 days, between 08:00 hours and approximately 18:00 hours each day.

Clubb Lane will be closed in sections, to the actual extent indicated on site at any time.

Please note that Clubbs Lane, the northern continuation of Clubb Lane, is currently closed due to subsidence.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Hook Wall, A259 Rye Road, Rectory Lane Roundabout and Boarman's Lane.
