CLUBB'S LANE, BROOKLAND, ROMNEY MARSH

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

TEMPORARY ORDER AUGUST 2021

To allow telegraph pole replacement works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Clubb's Lane, Brookland, Romney Marsh.

Daytime closures are planned from Wednesday 25 August 2021 for up to 3 days, between 08:00 hours and approximately 18:00 hours each day.

Clubb's Lane will be closed north west of the junction with Beacon Lane, to the actual extent shown on site.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Tillery Lane, Barnhouse Lane and Boarman's Lane.

The planned dates and duration may change for various reasons including the current coronavirus situation and adverse weather conditions, with any changes signposted on site and notified locally.
