TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14 (2)

Kent County Council gives notice that Earls Avenue, Folkestone will be closed to through traffic, on or after 12th April 2021 for up to 7 days.

The road will be closed between the junctions of Shorncliffe Road and Jointon Road.

The alternative route is via Earls Avenue, Shorncliffe Road, Castle Hill Avenue, Sandgate Road, Earls Avenue and vice versa.

This closure is necessary to enable drainage works to be carried out by Kent County Council.

This Notice applies when the relevant signs and barriers are on site and is valid for a period of no more than 21 days.
