**HOPE ALL SAINTS,
ST MARY IN THE MARSH**

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

TEMPORARY ORDER NOVEMBER 2021

To allow works to be carried out to provide a new water connection, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Hope All Saints, St Mary in the Marsh, Romney Marsh.

A closure is currently planned from Monday 1 November 2021, with estimated completion by 12 November 2021.

Hope All Saints will be closed from the junction with Chittenden Lane to Beechcroft Farm, to the actual extent shown on site.

The alternative route for through traffic is via Ashford Road, Newchurch Lane, un-named road from Newchurch, St Mary's Road, and un-named road from Turnagate Cottage to Hope Lane.

Due to the nature of the works, it will not be possible to re-open the road outside the working hours.

The planned dates and duration may change for various reasons including the current coronavirus situation and adverse weather conditions, with any changes signposted on site and notified locally.
