TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14 (2)

Kent County Council gives notice that Lympne Hill, Lypne will be closed to through traffic, on or after 3rd September 2021 for up to 3 days.

The road will be closed at the junctions of Aldington Road and St Marys Road.

The alternative route is via Aldington Road, Stone Street, A261 Hythe Road, A261 London Road, A259 Scanlons Bridge, A259 Dymchurch Road, Burmarsh Road, West Hythe Road and vice versa.

This closure is necessary to enable gully repairs to be carried out by Kent County Council.

This Notice applies when the relevant signs and barriers are on site and is valid for a period of no more than 5 days.
