ORGARSWICK AVENUE, DYMCHURCH

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) TEMPORARY ORDER 2021

To allow works to be carried out to provide a new water connection, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Organswick Avenue, Dymchurch.

A closure is currently planned from Monday 22 March 2021, with estimated completion by 26 March 2021.

Orgarswick Avenue will be closed in the general vicinity of the junction with A259 High Street, to the actual extent indicated on site.

Access to the remainder of Orgarswick Avenue, including the car park and Village Hall, continues via A259 High Street, Mill Road and Eastbridge Road.

Due to the nature of the works, it will not be possible to re-open the road outside the working hours.

The planned dates and duration may change for various reasons including the current coronavirus situation and adverse weather conditions, with any changes signposted on site and notified locally.
