**ORGARSWICK AVENUE, DYMCHURCH**

**(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)**

**TEMPORARY ORDER 2021**

**To allow works to be carried out to provide a new water connection, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Orgarswick Avenue, Dymchurch.**

**A closure is currently planned from Monday 22 March 2021, with estimated completion by 26 March 2021.**

**Orgarswick Avenue will be closed in the general vicinity of the junction with A259 High Street, to the actual extent indicated on site.**

**Access to the remainder of Orgarswick Avenue, including the car park and Village Hall, continues via A259 High Street, Mill Road and Eastbridge Road.**

**Due to the nature of the works, it will not be possible to re-open the road outside the working hours.**

**The planned dates and duration may change for various reasons including the current coronavirus situation and adverse weather conditions, with any changes signposted on site and notified locally.**
