

## SANDLING ROAD, SANDLING, SANDLING ROAD, SALTWOOD

## **TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING**

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14 (2)

Kent County Council gives notice that Sandling Road, Sandling and Sandling Road, Saltwood will be closed to through traffic, on or after 27th August 2024 for up to 5 days.

The road will be closed at the junctions of Highfield Close and The South entrance to Sandling Train station.

The alternative route is via Sandling Road, The Green, Brockhill Road, Hillcrest Road, North Road, Barrack Hill, London Road, Hythe Road, Ashford Road, Stanford Intersection and vice-versa.

It is planned that the road will be closed between 8:00 hrs and 17:00 hrs each day.

This closure is necessary to enable footway patching to be carried out by Kent County Council.

This Notice applies when the relevant signs and barriers are on site and is valid for a period of no more than 5 days.
