**(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)**

**TEMPORARY ORDER 2021**

**To allow works to be carried out to provide a new gas supply, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Seaway Road, St Mary's Bay, near Dymchurch.**

**A closure is currently planned from Monday 10 May 2021, with estimated completion by 14 May 2021.**

**Seaway Road will be closed in the general vicinity of the junction with A259 Dymchurch Road, to the actual extent shown on site.**

**The alternative route for through traffic is via A259 Dymchurch Road, Jefferstone Lane and Seaway Crescent.**

**Access to the remainder of Seaway Road continues via the above diversion.**

**Due to the nature of the works, it will not be possible to re-open the road outside the working hours.**

**The planned dates and duration may change for various reasons including the current coronavirus situation and adverse weather conditions, with any changes signposted on site and notified locally.**
