



## STONE STREET, STELLING MINNIS STONE STREET, MONKS HORTON, STONE STREET, STOWTING

## TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14 (2)

Kent County Council gives notice that Stone Street, Stelling Minnis Stone Street, Monks Horton, Stone Street, Stowting will be closed to through traffic, on or after 27th August 2024 for up to 3 days.

The road will be closed at the junctions of Pilgrims Way and Lime Kiln Lane.

The alternative route is via Stone Street, Street End, Hardres Court Road, School Lane, The Street, Bossingham Road, Wheelbarrow Town, High Minnis, The Minnis, Longage Hill, Canterbury Road, Station Road, Broad Street, Teddars Leas Road, Coombe Farm, Beachborough, Ashford Road, Sandling Road, Stanford Intersection, Stanford Bypass and vice-versa.

It is planned that the road will be closed between 20:00 hrs and 6:00 hrs each day.

This closure is necessary to enable carriageway patching to be carried out by Kent County Council.

This Notice applies when the relevant signs and barriers are on site and is valid for a period of no more than 5 days.
