**ST MARY'S ROAD TO NEWCHURCH LANE,  
NEWCHURCH**

**(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)**

**TEMPORARY ORDER 2020**

To allow culvert repairs to be safely carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of the un-named road from St Mary's Road to Newchurch Lane, Newchurch, Romney Marsh.

A closure is currently planned from Monday 26 October 2020, with estimated completion by 6 November 2020.

St Mary's Road to Newchurch Lane will be closed in the general vicinity of Starveacre Bridge, with no through access between the junction with Pickney Bush Lane and the village of Newchurch.

There will be a signposted diversion via Gammons Farm Lane and un-named roads through Newchurch.

Due to the nature of the works, it will not be possible to re-open the road outside the working hours.
