EASTBRIDGE ROAD, DYMCHURCH

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

TEMPORARY ORDER 2021

To allow bank stabilisation works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Eastbridge Road, Dymchurch.

The ongoing closure from 1 March 2021 has now been extended for operational reasons, with revised estimated completion by 4 July 2021.

Eastbridge Road is being closed in phases northwards from the level crossing, to the actual extent shown at any time.

The alternative route for through traffic is via St Mary's Road, unnamed roads to and through Newchurch (shown on some maps as The Street) back to Eastbridge Road, as signposted on site.

Due to the nature of the works, it will not be possible to re-open the road outside the working hours.

The planned dates and duration may change for various reasons including the current coronavirus situation, and updated information can be found on www.one.network – [Kent County Council Permit GE70580979767], with any changes signposted on site and notified locally.
