**HOOK WALL, BROOKLAND,
ROMNEY MARSH**

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

TEMPORARY ORDER 2020

To allow works to be carried out to provide a new water connection, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Hook Wall, Brookland, Romney Marsh.

A closure is currently planned from Monday 14 December 2020, with estimated completion by 18 December 2020.

Hook Wall will be closed in the general vicinity of the junction with Cheyne Court, to the extent shown on site.

The alternative route for through traffic is via Hook Wall, Hook Lane, A259 Rye Road, Brookland Bypass, Straight Lane, Rhee Wall, Swamp Road, Wheelsgate Lane and Midley Wall.

Local access to the remainder of Hook Wall / Midley Wall continues from either direction up to where the road is actually closed.

Due to the nature of the works, it will not be possible to re-open the road outside the working hours.

The planned dates and duration may change for various reasons including the current coronavirus situation, and updated information can be found on www.one.network – [South East Water Permit EB006-24188376], with any changes signposted on site and notified locally.
